Mr. Ashwin Gandhi, President of the Association thanked all the members and briefed about various activities of the Association. Following agenda was taken up for discussion in the meeting:

1. Minutes of the 11<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 21.04.2014 held at Mumbai were read out and approved in the meeting.
2. On the wish of Mr. C.P Sanghvi his resignation from the association was accepted by all the E.C Members and the message has also been conveyed to him that whenever he feels like re-joining the association he is most welcome.
3. President explained members that how he got the Refund of RTO tax on Crawler cranes in Gujarat and also suggested those members who have paid the RTO tax on crawler cranes, they must apply for the refund as early as possible. Members can contact Mr. Ravi Sheth at Jamnagar, whose contact numbers have been circulated by the GS. 7.5% of the total refund amount will have to be paid to COAOI, out of which service charges will be paid to Mr. Sheth.
4. It was decided by the E.C Members that in the next meeting Dun Brad rating agency should be called for the presentation on Minimization of Risk in Crane Renting Business, which will be beneficial to all the members of the COAOI, to know the credit rating and each company's financial condition will be known from the agency's website. D&B will be requested to give presentation to all the EC members.
5. President informed the members that as of now the new government has been formed at the Centre; so a strong representation by COAOI to the Central Government on the service tax issue and other related issues will be made soon.
6. The Notice received by G. R. Infrastructure on Sales Tax Issue was circulated to all E.C. Members and the contact details of the lady advocate who is looking to the Sales tax Issues of most our members will be circulated to all members of the association very soon.
7. President Informed all the members that registered office address of COAOI will be changed from Vyapar Bhavan to Malhotra Chambers, Deonar soon as the procedure for change of address is in the last stage. President also informed that as soon as the whole process gets completed, a circular of change in regd. address will be circulated to all the members and non-members for their information.

8. On the outstanding payment issue of WWIL, all the E.C Members decided that a meeting with Mr. Yogesh Mehra of WWIL should be organized to resolve the Issue as soon as possible. It was decided that of behalf of its members, COAOI must write to WWIL for an appointment with Mr. Mehra and once the time and date for the meeting is confirmed by WWIL, the same will be conveyed to all the members who are having their outstanding issues with WWIL so they can join the meeting. President called Mr. Bipin Lunavia, who agreed to meet the members of COAOI, but not without Mr. Mehra. A detailed proposal from WWIL was called for by the President.

9. Mr. Udayan Mookerjee of Ideal Movers explained about the difficulties and harassment being faced by Crane Owners at different check posts in Rajasthan State. Regarding this various other crane owners also expressed their hardships and difficulties with regard to the entry and exit of cranes at various check posts in Rajasthan. Because of the difficulties being faced in Rajasthan, crane owners do not want to work in Rajasthan. It was felt very important that COAOI must send a strong representation to the Transport Ministry in Rajasthan so that the R.T.O Issues at Rajasthan Border could be sorted out as soon as possible.

10. All E.C Members thanked Mr. Premal Thaker for providing office space for the office work of COAOI from April 2013 to March 2014 at very much subsidized rate. Full and final payment of rent amounts have been made by way of Cheques (No. 797436 and No. 803014).

11. It was decided to call the next meeting of the Executive Committee of COAOI by end of June 2014 at Mumbai.

The Meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
