

MINUTES OF MEETING

Mr. Ashwin Gandhi, President of the Association welcomed all the members and non members present in the meeting and gave a brief report about various activities of the Association. Following agenda was taken up for the discussion in the meeting.

1. President informed about his meeting which is scheduled to be on 17.12.2014 at the Parliament House with Mr. Arun Jaitley, Honorable Finance Minister for service tax issue (i.e; transfer of service tax from service provider to service receiver) which is also a major concern for the crane renting industry and with Mr. Nitin Gadkari Honorable Transport Minister for requesting him to issue National Permit for smooth transporting of Cranes from one state to another.
2. Crane Owners from Delhi NCR have been personally invited by General Secretary of COAOI on phone and e-mail for attending the meeting and they have also confirmed there presence but non remain present. Other Non Members present in the meeting were asked to join COAOI.
3. Most of the Members thanked President for getting refund of RTO tax with Interest on entry of crawler cranes from Gujarat RTO's.
4. Mr. Rajesh Shorilal, of Deewanchand Ramsaran Corporation Pvt. Ltd. informed that decision on sales tax demanded by the Government of Maharashtra on renting of cranes

has been challenged in the Supreme Court and he also suggested that COAOI can also file a petition on the above case.

5. President informed that he had invited HOTA (Hydraulic Truck Owners Association) to become member of COAOI and said COAOI will also become member of HOTA so problems related to both the associations can be taken up more aggressively to the concerned authorities of State and Central Government.
6. President informed that members can send their defaulter client list with complete details of the defaulter company to the Association, so that a letter on behalf of COAOI can be written and the outstanding issues can be dealt more aggressively.
7. Mr. Miyashita and Mr. Nilesh Bhorkar of Kobelco were present after the meeting to whom COAOI President thanked for their arrangements and hospitality provided. Kobelco also assured that whenever COAOI wants to use such facilities they are always welcome for that and need not go to any other stall in future.

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the chair.
